Associate of Arts to
Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Arts degree at Cincinnati State and leads to the Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies degree at Northern Kentucky University.

Applying to the CState2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Cincinnati State, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Cincinnati State.

Degree Requirements for Cincinnati State

1) Completion of minimum 62 credit hours, 36 of which from approved Ohio Transfer 36 courses, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) completion of an FYE course as part of the first 12 credit hours taken at Cincinnati State, and 4) completion of Cooperative Education.

Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

This major can be completed face-to-face or online. If completed fully online, courses are offered primarily in seven-week formats. Tuition for online accelerated programs differs from face-to-face tuition. Scholarship pricing is available to CState students who choose to enroll in the fully online program. The General Studies Track is available only in the accelerated online format and is open to students with at least 60 credit hours. Visit our website for more information about the

Degree Requirements for NKU

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0 and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies – Integrated Studies Track:

- 1) Student must earn a minimum average GPA 2.0 across all major coursework
- 2) Student must earn at least a C- in each course for any minor or area of specialty, and a 2.0 (C average) in each minor or area of specialty. Some minors require higher GPAs/grade minimums. The higher standard applies.)
- 3) Student must complete minors or areas of specialty in three different academic programs.
- 4) At least one content area must be chosen from the College of Arts and Sciences.
- 5) Student must complete the introductory experience, IST 185, and the capstone experiences, (IST 397 & IST 497).
- 6) No additional minor or area of specialty is required beyond the three used to complete the degree requirements.
- 7) No course can count in more than one area of specialty or minor.

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies – General Studies Track:

- 1) Student must earn a minimum average GPA 2.0 across all major coursework.
- 2) Student must complete an area of specialty.
- 3) Student must earn at least a C- in each course in the area of specialty, and a 2.0 (C average) in the area of specialty.
- 4) Student must complete IST 185, IST 397, and one capstone course in any discipline (can be IST 497).
- 5) No additional minor or area of specialty is required.

Students within this pathway are **strongly** encouraged to work closely with their assigned NKU advisor to determine their areas of specialty and to determine the best classes to take at Cincinnati State to facilitate a smooth transfer into those areas of specialty.

Advising Note

Students in the CState2NKU program should work closely with their advisors when choosing courses. This document serves as a guide but does not replace academic advising. When choosing Cincinnati State courses, student may also consult the Associate of Arts advising brochure or the catalog for A and B list courses in Arts and Humanities or Social and Behavioral Sciences.

Integrated Studies Track

Students seeking the Bachelor of Arts degree in Interdisciplinary Studies (BAIS) – Integrated Studies Track must complete minors or areas of specialty in three disciplinary or interdisciplinary programs. The requirements for a minor in any program are listed in the relevant department’s pages in the catalog. An area of specialty is defined as 12 credit hours at the 300 level or above in any disciplinary or interdisciplinary program (major or minor). The three areas of study must include at least one area from the College of Arts and Sciences.

We also require IST 185, an introduction to Interdisciplinary Studies, and IST 497, the capstone course, which involves both a portfolio of artifacts and an Interdisciplinary final project.

Through the CState2NKU program a student can attain an Associate’s degree from Cincinnati State and then transfer to NKU to complete a Bachelor’s degree. In the Integrated Studies program students work

with advisors to design their own course of study from across the curriculum and integrate what they learn in a capstone project to find coherence, meaning and value in a personal area of interest. Below are just a few examples of pathways that appeal to many students.

- ***I would be interested in a career as a paralegal, legal assistant or legal administrator.*** A sample plan of study includes an area of specialty in Professional Writing, and areas of specialty in Communication Studies and Philosophy. Other programs of study include History, Political Science, International Studies, English, Anthropology, Law, and Human Resource Management.
- ***I want a career in arts management.*** A sample plan of study includes an area of specialty in one or more of the arts, Public Relations, and Art History. Other programs to consider include English, Professional Writing, History, and Education.
- ***I am interested in environmental issues.*** A sample plan of study includes an area of specialty in Environmental Studies, an area of specialty in Geography, and an area of specialty in Sociology. Other programs to consider include Biology, Chemistry, English, Geology, Environmental Education and Social Justice.
- ***I want to work with family services.*** A sample plan of study includes areas of specialty in Human Services and Addiction, Psychology, and Sociology. Other programs to consider include Social Work, Education, Women’s and Gender Studies, Health Education, Health Science, Black Studies, and Social Justice.
- ***I want to be involved in hospitality, event planning and promotion.*** A sample plan of study includes areas of specialty in Psychology, Public Relations, and Communication Studies. Other programs to consider include Theater, Human Resource Management, Sociology, Organizational Leadership, Professional Writing, and Media Informatics.
- ***I want to write and produce media about popular culture.*** A sample plan of study includes areas of specialty in Cinema Studies, Journalism, and Popular Culture Studies. Other programs to consider include Electronic Media Broadcasting, Anthropology, Music, Art History, and English.

Arts Management. What kinds of careers are available? Operas, symphonies, dance companies, record labels, museums, public radio or television, event promoters, marketing and media relations.
